Yes things are very tough, but the 7 youth services staff members are here to serve you and your students. We continue to find ways to grow and expand our services with minimal impact to our budget such as ebooks (from our Friends), outreach visits, TAB, and new and exciting programs. While our materials budget has been slashed 80% in three fiscal years, we continue to buy materials that let our teens read for recreational enjoyment, keep the classics and required reading on the self, and keep the new materials that are needed for Common Core in mind.
